# 'Freemason II' - on patrol

In 2014, **Freemasons on the Central Coast** began their working relationship with Terrigal Surf Life Saving Club, commencing with the provision of pink 'rashies' to all Nippers and Seniors who participated in Carnivals, as a safety measure.



In the same year Freemasons on the Central Coast donated an Inflatable Rescue Boat (IRB) to replace the current model which had seen better days. It was appropriately named '**Freemason I**'.

Did you know that **Surf Life Saving - Central Coast** was the first Surf Life Saving organisation to provide pink 'rashies' to their competitors. Their remit extends from 'The Lakes Beach' in the North to 'Umina Beach' in the South, a total of 15 beaches.

In late 2019, Terrigal Surf Life Saving Club approached Freemasons on the Central Coast again, requesting assistance in purchasing another IRB as their current IRB, the **'Freemason I'**, was now five years old and a new IRB design had been proven to be more appropriate to surf conditions in their area.

The goal is that **'Freemason I'** will still be maintained and available as a support vessel and as a training IRB, with the new IRB taking over as the primary vessel.



**'Freemason II'** and **'Freemason I'** with Graeme Ingall, Sue and Chris Matthews from Freemasons on the Central Coast, with representatives of Terrigal SLSC.

In early March the new IRB, **'Freemason II'**, arrived and testing commenced. Then on 21 March, with both IRBs in attendance and raring to go, **Freemasons on the Central Coast** joined with Terrigal Surf Club representatives, at Terrigal Beach for the official presentation.

With the IRB raring to go, Sue and Chris Matthews and Graeme Ingall from the **'Freemasons on the Central Coast'** attended.
